What do you think about special girl lines: Do you think there is a difference in the desires of male and female sneaker lovers? That's a hard question. I mean, I have mixed opinions, depending on how the line looks. Overall, I have to say I primarily look at men's sneakers, cuz there's just a much better selection. And there's something funny about the category »girl» that makes smart, creative people all of a sudden limit their colors to pink and their accessories to handbags. Well, that's not impressive to me, but I think we're going to start seeing a lot more creativity coming out with more highprofile female sneaker designers, more small and innovative new sneaker brands, as well as just more visibility for the female consumer. they can't even find them anywhere near their size. And the sneaker boutiques don't help: sometimes they don't even carry stuff under an 8 or 8.5 (US men's), even when it comes out smaller.
